The Fair will have activities for all ages. Kids can build a bluebird house while they learn about the importance of natural diversity. Or they can watch how water flows through a model of our landscape to see the effects of pesticide use on lawn and fields. Of course, there will be food provided by local vendors to please all generations and cooking demonstrations, too.
