Temporary Sign Specifications

(attachment to Temporary Sign Application)

1. Signs are permitted to be posted 30 days before the date of event.
2. Signs are to be removed within three days after the event.
3. One sign per street frontage per property.
4. Permission to place a sign on a property must be granted from the property owner.
5. Signs must be placed 10 feet off the road edge, out of site triangles and placed as not to create traffic hazards.
6. Signs cannot be placed on utility poles.
7. Temporary sign application must be submitted to the Zoning Officer and approved before signs are put in place.
8. Signs must follow all regulations set forth in the South Coventry Zoning Ordinance adopted April 24, 2001 as currently amended.

Specific Requirement for ALL Election Signs

A \$100 fee must be posted to the Township Secretary-Treasurer for each candidate or group of candidates prior to any elections signs being erected in South Coventry Township. This fee is refundable if and when signs are removed within 48 hours after the closing of the polls. *(as per Resolution 92-7-1 of the Board of Supervisors)*
