



## S O U T H C O V E N T R Y T O W N S H I P

Dear Ridglea Water System User,

We are pleased to inform you that South Coventry Township was awarded a grant through the ARPA PA Small Water and Sewer Grant Program to perform essential maintenance on the water storage tower serving the Ridglea Water System. The Township received notification of this grant in December 2023.

Unfortunately, due to a valve issue this past spring, the project was delayed until the valve could be replaced. The replacement is scheduled for the week of September 23, 2024. Once this valve work is completed, the water tower will be drained to allow maintenance on the tower to proceed. We expect all work to be completed by October 14, 2024.

Please note that the water tower must remain empty for the duration of the project. As a result, fire hydrants will be offline while the water tower is disconnected from the system. You will see "Out of Service" bags placed on the hydrants as a precaution. This ensures that hydrants are not used during this period.

Rest assured, the Ridge Fire Company has been notified and is fully equipped with the necessary equipment and tankers to respond to emergencies in South Coventry Township.

Although the wells supplying the Ridglea Water System are capable of meeting regular water demand, you may notice occasional fluctuations in water pressure during the repairs. We kindly ask all users to be mindful of their water usage during this time. Please avoid unnecessary or excessive water use, such as watering lawns, using power washers, or filling pools while the water tower is offline.

We greatly appreciate your cooperation and understanding during this important maintenance project.
